We urge parents to purchase the appropriate plain solid colour t-shirts for their children as the school inter-house swimming gala will be taking place on 21st February 2025


GR R LIMITED SPACE AVAILABLE

STARTING TIME

<u>Parents please note: School starts promptly at 7:35.</u> Please ensure that your child is dropped off at school well before this time but not earlier than 7:00.

If your child is late more than five times, the Late Coming Policy will be implemented. Missing out on a classroom morning routine disrupts their day. Please make allowances for heavy traffic and robots not working and leave home a little earlier so that your child is at school well before the bell rings

FINISHING TIME FOR THE WHOLE SCHOOL

GRADE R 13:00 GRADE 1 - 2 13:15 GRADE 3 - 7 13:45

Grade R -2 parents are to fetch their children from 13:00 - 13:45 from inside the school.

Please ensure that your child is fetched BEFORE 14:30. This does not apply to children involved in extra-mural activities. Children being fetched after that must be enrolled at the Care Centre for safety reasons. Learners who are walking home must leave straight after school and are not to loiter. Loitering attracts children from other schools to come onto the property. We are trying to prevent theft, getting up to mischief, playing in the car park amongst the teachers' cars and damaging them, as well as the learners running in the street. Unsupervised learners on School property are also at risk in the afternoons.

A letter from the SGB will be sent to parents of repeat offenders staying late. Note that the school is working closely with the South African Police Service to assist with late stayers as well as continuous misconduct.



TRANSPORT PROVIDERS

We appeal to both Parents/Guardians and Transport Providers to refrain from encouraging learners to cross on Mendelssohn Road in order to wait for their lift outside the Church. The speed hump is NOT a zebra crossing as some people assume.

Those drivers of vehicles who do park across the street must leave their vehicle, collect the learners from outside the school and walk them safely across the street.
